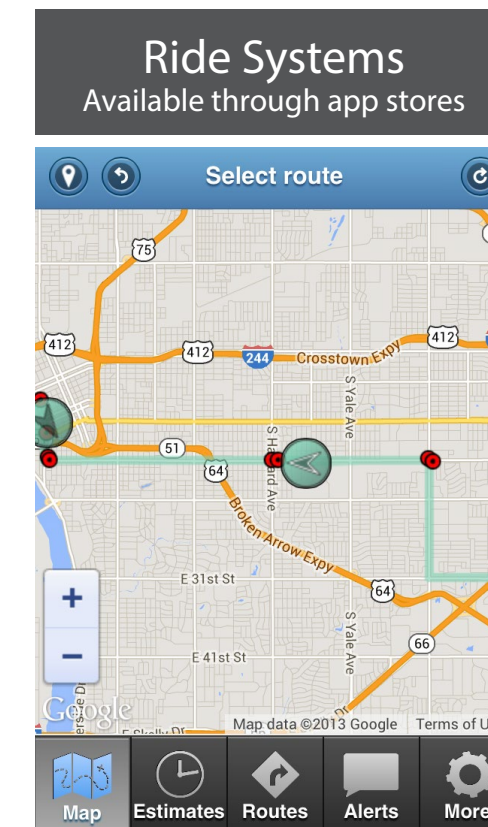
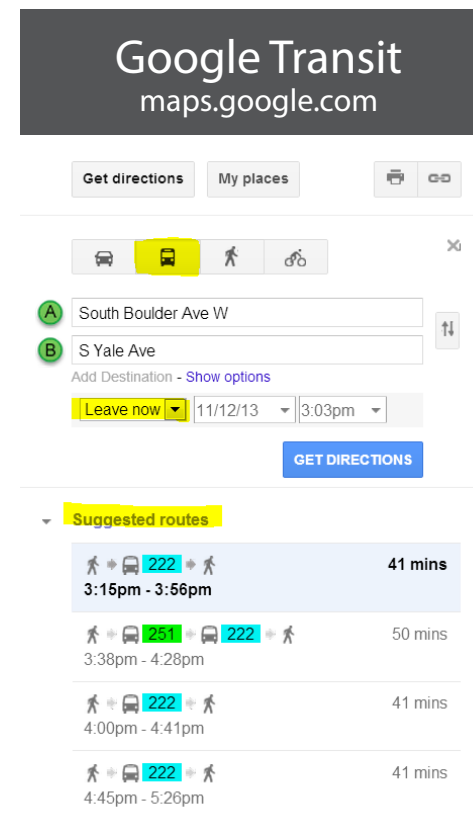

Tools for Riding Tulsa Transit Fixed Route

Planning Your Trip

- Use Google Maps online or on your smart phone to find the best route from point A to point B.
- Use Tulsa Transit's Trip Planner to find your way: tulsatransit.org/maps-schedules/trip-planner/
- **NEW!** Track your bus online or on your phone in real time using the Ride Systems App. Just download the free Ride Systems application and select 'Tulsa Transit' from the agency list.
- **NEW!** From your bus stop, text to find out when your bus will arrive. Look for the bus stop number on the back of the bus stop sign. Send a text to: 41411
Text: Tulsa (bus stop #) ex: Tulsa 6067 (don't forget the space!)
Hit send. Within moments you will get a text with the ETA for your bus!
